Planning

This topic is intended to help you plan the implementation of your environment. There are many things that need to be taken into consideration when planning your implementation of product x.



Physical planning

Determine whether or not you are building a test or production environment. This will help you determine how many machines are required. A test environment can be set up using only one machine.

Requirements

Hardware requirements

A computer with a processor

256MB memory

At least 10MB of disk space

Software requirements

A Web browser for viewing the information

A Web server

Installing

Before you begin installation make sure you have reviewed and met all of the requirements described in the planning section. It is also that you uninstall any previous versions of this software.



To install:

1. Insert the CD.
2. Go to **Start > Run** and locate setup.exe on the CD.
3. Enter the appropriate information asked for during the installation program.
4. Click **Finish** when you are ready to begin installation.

After installation

View the logs to ensure there were no errors.

Configuring

Once installation is complete you must configure some things for your environment. You must customize your settings with your username and password and enter your e-mail address.
